

Dump Cake

Level: Easy

Serves: about 14



Prep Time: 25 minutes

Cook Time: 30 minutes



- 1 box Devil's Food cake mix, (plus eggs, vegetable oil, and water to make cake)
- 2 (3.9 oz.) boxes instant chocolate pudding, (plus 4 cups milk to make pudding)
- 1 (16 oz.) container Cool Whip
- 1 (12 oz.) package Heath Miniatures, unwrapped and chopped into small pieces

Bake cake in a 9x13 pan as directed on the box. Cool and cut into small squares.

Prepare pudding as directed on the box. Refrigerate until ready to layer.

In a large trifle bowl, place half of the cut cake on the bottom (does not have to be even). For the next layer, add half of the pudding. Next, layer half of the Cool Whip. Sprinkle half of the chopped Heath bars onto the Cool Whip. Repeat the layering again using the remaining halves- cake, pudding, Cool Whip, and Heath bars. Refrigerate until ready to serve.

Notes:

- For more of a presentation, pipe the top layer of Cool Whip with a pastry bag using a star tip.
- I prefer using Heath Miniatures because I like the additional chocolate, but you can also use Heath Bits 'O Brickle Toffee Bits (has no chocolate) or regular Heath bars.
- For a different variation, add a layer of bottled caramel sauce between the pudding and Cool Whip. Or add a splash of Kahlua to the cake before layering the pudding over it.
